## Competition terms and conditions

WeekendPlus prides itself on holding a variety of competitions that appeal to the broad interests and activities of our readers. Competitions are held on a fortnightly basis and adhere to the *Lottery and Gaming Regulations 2008*.

- WeekendPlus competitions and promotions are available to South Australian Seniors Card members. All employees of the promoter (Office for Ageing Well) and its related bodies corporate are ineligible to enter.
- Only one entry will be captured per person per competition.
- All Seniors Card members who enter a competition are eligible to win a prize provided they have not won a major prize within the past six months (excludes movie tickets or prizes under \$50 in value).
- All information detailing prizes and how to enter competitions forms part of these terms and conditions. Submission of entries will be taken to mean acceptance of these terms and conditions.
- Winners will be drawn through a random process. All entries that fulfil the competition entry criteria will be eligible.
- All draws will take place at the Seniors Card Unit, 11 Hindmarsh Square, Adelaide.
- The Seniors Card Unit will notify all competition winners by email or telephone within seven business days of the competition being drawn.
- Winners agree for their first initial and surname to be published in WeekendPlus.
- Winners agree for the Seniors Card Unit to pass on their details to a promoter for distribution of prizes only. In this instance, the Seniors Card Unit will inform all entrants of this method before the competition is held.
- Prizes must be collected in person from the Seniors Card Unit office, 11 Hindmarsh Square, Adelaide, unless otherwise arranged with the Seniors Card Unit.
  - In the case of winners being located in regional/rural areas, the Seniors Card Unit will post prizes (regional post codes only).
  - Should prizes be posted to winners, the Seniors Card Unit takes no responsibility after prize has left the Seniors Card office for items not received.
- All prizes are non-transferable and cannot be exchanged or taken for cash.
- Prizes will be held up to one month from the date the winner/s is notified. The winner will surrender their prize if they have not contacted the Seniors Card Unit prior to this date to arrange collection.
- The promoter's decision is final and binding and no correspondence will be entered into.
- All entrants release the Seniors Card Unit, Office for Ageing Well from any and all causes of action, losses, liability, damage, expense (including legal expenses) cost or charge suffered, sustained or in any way incurred by the winner as a result of any loss or damage to any physical property of the winner, or any injury to or death of any person arising out of, or related to, or in any way connected with the promotion/s.
